Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

### How to Cite a Book in APA Style | Format & Examples

An in-text citation is a citation within your writing that shows where you found your information, facts, quotes, and research. All APA in-text citations require the same basic information: Author's last name (no first names or initials) Year of publication (or "n.d." if there is "no date": (LastName, n.d., p.#))

To cite a textbook in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author(s) of the textbook: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

To cite a textbook in APA in text, include the author's last name in parentheses at the end of the sentence you're sourcing, followed by the publication date. For example, you would write, "(Johnson, 2018)." If there are multiple authors, list all of their last names in parentheses.

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

APA style is a common requirement for papers written in the social sciences. When you are using a textbook as a source in your References list, you cite it the same way you would cite any other book. Type the first author's name. You type her last name first, followed by a comma, followed by her initials. It looks like this: Koslowski, M. J.

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name(s) of the author(s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author(s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

APA citation basics. When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, like, for example, (Jones, 1998). One complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

References - An APA reference page is the place where you list each source that you have cited via an APA in-text citation within the body of your paper. Running Head - Running head is the name of APA headings that are used in research papers. They contain the title of the paper, the page number, and the term "Running head."

### The Right Way to List Book References in APA Format

To create an in-text citation in APA format when the author is an organization or entity, always include the full name of the organization the first time you cite the source in-text. The citation should also include the acronym of the organization if one is available. Subsequent citations can simply list the acronym and the publication date.
