An edited book is a book in which different people have written different chapters, and the chapters have been compiled or put together by an editor. If you used information from just one chapter of an edited book, cite the chapter you used in the reference list.

### Book chapters: What to cite

• These examples are for chapters or parts of edited works in which the chapters or parts have an individual title and author/s, but are included in collections or textbooks edited by others. • If the editors of a work are also the authors of all of the included chapters, then it should be cited as a whole book using the examples given for Books .

Before getting into the real content of the chapter, write down a summary of this preview paragraph in the outline. Your goal here is to give yourself a good idea of what the chapter is about. This particular preview paragraph is short.

Are the books indexed in services that you use? – Is your book or chapter indexed or archived in an easily discoverable database? Does the publisher ensure long term archiving and preservation of digital publications, such as via OAPEN or CLOCKSS? – Does the publisher use permanent digital identifiers for books and/or chapters?

For book chapters with 2 authors, list both last names, separated by the word “and.” For example: (Harris and Smith 29). For book chapters with 3 or more authors, just include the first listed author followed by the phrase “et al” and a period. For example: (Harris et al. 29).

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author’s name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

Most books use only one page to delineate a new chapter, but there are times when authors or designers want to use a pair of pages in a two-page spread for every chapter. Usually this means there will be a graphic of some kind on the left-hand (verso) page, and the text of the chapter opener on the right-hand page (recto).

A chapter book is a story book intended for intermediate readers, generally age 7-10. Unlike picture books for younger readers, a chapter book tells the story primarily through prose, rather than pictures. Unlike books for older readers, chapter books contain plentiful illustrations.

A chapter book is a typically a fiction book written for children who are ready to transition from picture books to more text based books. Many early reader chapter books still include simple illustrations – though the pictures are generally less important to the story than they are in a picture book.

In books that have individual chapters written by different authors, the book is considered the container because it contains parts of a larger whole. The title of the first container, the book name, is printed in italics and follows the chapter name. When accessing book chapters through a database, the database is considered the second container.
